

January 2024

With warmest greetings to each of you in the most precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ! We welcome the new year 2024 with the theme: 'A Year of Revival Breakthrough' and together with the Board of Elders and the Pastoral Team of CBC, we wish you and family a God-centred and faith-infused year in 2024 as we declare together that the faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh in 2024 (Lam 3:22-23).

In 2024, we are celebrating the 50th anniversary of CBC. This year is a time for reflection, renewal, restoration and reconnection. Many periods of the history of CBC as a church have been joyful, hope-filled and faith-inspired breakthroughs. However, we acknowledge that there had been broken relationships in our past and as we look back, we can see that there had been periods of disunity in the history of the church. Our hope in this new season of revival breakthrough brings with it the opportunity to reconcile, and to share the burdens of those past pains, while moving forward together keeping our eyes on Jesus and away from ourselves. We want to consider to align each of our individual life, work, family, parenting, marriage and ministry and church with the theme 'A Year of Revival Breakthrough.' We want to define the shape, the contents and the expressions of all church ministries and church missions with the theme. We want to experience the revival breakthrough anointing in all aspects of life across CBC and beyond.

In 1 Chronicles 14:1-17, we read that when the Philistines heard David had been anointed king over all Israel, they came together to attack him. How did David handle the grave situation? There

are a few thoughts I want to share with you from this passage to help us to align with the Lord and His purpose in 'The Year of Revival Breakthrough.'

#1 David knew the Lord had established him as king over Israel (v.2). Thus, he led the nation with confidence, clarity and concentration of focus. He did not waver but rather he sought the Lord again and again. Likewise, let us acknowledge God as the One Who has established CBC fifty years ago with the redemptive purpose to plant churches and take the land. Let us persevere to stand on our identity and calling in Christ in 'The Year of Revival Breakthrough.'

#2 David sought the face of God, declaring his dependence on God. He sought the Lord for permission to attack the Philistines and for God's blessing and protection (v.10). In subsequent attack by the Philistines, he sought the Lord again and God gave him another strategy (vv.14-15). David did not depend on past revelation from God. Each day, he renewed his relationship with God. Likewise, let us seek God's face in prayer as a daily habit. Prayer is the key for breakthrough.

Prayer is one of God's appointed means for meeting our needs (see James 4:2). Prayer is essential if we want to see the power of God's work in our own lives and in the lives of those we care about. Prayer is also something we need to grow in. We never graduate from the school of prayer, but that does not mean we should stay at kindergarten level. Prayer means much more than telling God our needs and asking for His help. Prayer also involves developing a closer relationship with the Father and the Son through the ministry of the Holy Spirit as we wait on God, commune with Him and hear His voice. As we grow in our prayer life, we come to understand God's will better and know what to pray for and how to ask when we do not know. It

also means making ourselves available to be a part of the answer if God calls us to act because God wants to work through us as well as for us (Ephesians 3:20). Faith and prayer go together, otherwise prayer is only a meaningless religious ritual. We see in the next point that David took steps of faith to obey the Lord.

#3 David did as God commanded him and as a result, he and his army drove the Philistines from Gibeon and as far as Gezer (v.16). We see here that complete obedience is necessary for breakthrough.

#4 David was not afraid of opposition from the enemies. It is recorded for us that 'when the Philistines heard that David had been anointed

king over all Israel, they went up in full force to search for him, but David heard about it and went out to meet them (v.8). We will expect opposition especially when we choose to do God's will. Jesus told His disciples: "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world" (John 16:33). Into 2024, let us put on the full armour of God so that we will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil (Ephesians 6:11) and step out in faith.

Therefore, we begin the year with a 3-day Fast and Pray with the theme – 'A Call to Seek the LORD.' Below is the agenda and dynamics for the 3-day Fast and Pray.
