## Senior Pastor's Message

With my warm greetings in the most precious name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

As we stand at the gate of 2023, I would like us to make a prayer declaration:

Great is the LORD and most worthy of praise; He is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the nations are idols, but the LORD made the heavens. To whom will we compare God? Or who is His equal? Majestic in holiness, awesome in glory, working wonders! We are His witnesses; before Him, no god was formed, nor will there be one after Him. He is the LORD our God, apart from Him there is no Savior! (Psalm 96; Isaiah 46).

In 2023, we declare that the LORD God will lead us to live triumphantly in Jesus. We will rejoice in the LORD. We will take joy in the God of our salvation. We declare the LORD God is our strength. He will make our feet like deer's feet. And He will make us walk on our high hills (Habakkuk 3:18-19).

O Lord Jesus Christ, perfect all good things concerning us this year. Give us anointed ideas and lead us to new paths of bountiful blessings this year, according to the good pleasure of the Father. O God of new beginnings, begin a new dimension of wonders in our lives this year, in the name of Jesus. Let our lives experience continual revival fire this year, in the name of Jesus. Let new things begin to spring forth in our lives this year, in the name of Jesus!

O Lord Jesus Christ, we enthrone you as Lord and Master of our lives, our finances and our families and over Your Church this year, in the name of Jesus!

O Lord Jesus Christ, we beseech You to help us to be steadfast and immovable, always abounding in the works of the Lord, knowing that our labor is not in vain in the Lord (1 Corinthians 15:58), in the name of Jesus! Lead us in triumph in Christ and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place (2 Corinthians 2:14).

O Holy Spirit, anoint our hearts to love the Lord our God with all our hearts, our souls, minds, with all our strength and to love our neighbor as ourselves. Baptize us once again with the fire of holiness, righteousness

and courage to live out our lives before the world, in the name of Jesus! Anoint us to be a passionate community of Christ's disciples committed to the greatest commandment fulfilling the Great Commission, in the name of Jesus! Amen.

We are entering 2023 with the theme: "A Year of Revival Anointing." This is the year to prepare our hearts for revival. This is the year to seek God passionately, to know Him in a deeper manner, to love Him wholeheartedly and to serve Him diligently. This is the year to go deeper in our personal relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. This is the year to read the bible from cover to cover. This is the year to cultivate prayer as a daily lifestyle with the Lord, not when we need Him, but practicing God's presence through prayer throughout the day. This is the year to cry out to the Lord for a fresh encounter with Him and a fresh outpouring of His Spirit. This is the year to grow as an apostolic and prophetic people of faith, courage and hope.

We will begin the year by establishing a mindset for victory. Our mind is in enmity with God and so we must develop a dynamic of victory and triumph within our spirit man. We had crossed the year 2022 and I felt the Spirit of God quicken within me the need to encourage us to stop and establish a rear guard over the headway we have made last year. I know some of us have experienced some hard times, but, even in the midst of our struggles, let us open our eyes to His victory for us and secure our future ahead. Remember, victory includes overcoming obstacles, confronting our enemies, pressing past blockages and living in a mentality of godly triumph.

To do so, we will begin the new year with a 3-day fast and pray, incorporating a 7-day prayer journey from 1-7 January 2023. There will be a 3-part dynamic to our prayer journey:

Day 1 – Establish Our Rear Guard

Day 2-5 – Press Into Our Next Measure

Day 6-7 – Prepare Ourselves for the Unexpected

This 7-day prayer journey will culminate in the Vision Casting Sunday on 8 January 2023. Let's come together with one mind, one heart and one purpose on this prayer journey at the beginning of the year. For prayer demonstrates our dependence upon God. Prayer honors God as the source of all blessing. Prayer is our communion with God. Prayer helps us develop our relationship with a loving Father who wants to provide nourishment, healing grace and refreshing

for our souls. Prayer gives us the perspective of God. Prayer is the greatest power God has put into our hands for service – praying is the harder work than doing the work itself. Yes, prayer is the greater work.

Beside this prayer journey, the first preaching series of 2023 from 15 January 2023 to 19 March 2023 is also about prayer with the preaching theme entitled 'Preparing for Revival – Prayer Principles from the Life of Elijah.' The purpose of prayer is to better know and serve God through the power of Jesus Christ. Prayer invites the supernatural and transcendental God into our ordinary daily life. Through prayer we surrender our will and desires to God, and allow the Holy Spirit to lead us where He will use us and bless us. Through this preaching series, we hope all Christ's disciples to develop and grow their Christian life, a life of purposeful prayer with limitless possibilities.

In addition, through this preaching series, we hope to do a thorough study of what Scripture has to say regarding prayer that will help us to practice and understand God's work in our lives. We also hope that CBC people cultivate prayer not only as an individual activity but also to participate in small group prayer, pray as a church, and even as a community of churches in a region and nation.

So, dearly beloved, let us arise into 2023 and cultivate prayer as a daily lifestyle, central to all we are and all we do daily. Prayer IS theologically significant – not for what it can do for us, but more for what it can bring us back to! Prayer brings us home to God. Until WE ARE desperate that we have nothing, prayer is merely incidental (secondary), or at best, supplemental (add-on) in our lives but it will never be FUNDAMENTAL (central). It is not God who needs our prayer, but we who need God – not as the cosmic answer to our questions, nor the celestial solution to our problems, but for WHO HE IS and for who we are when we are IN HIM. The year 2023 will bring greater challenges to our faith in the midst of a rapidly-changing socio-political-religious-economic landscape of our nation.

Dearly beloved, I issue this biblical challenge to us to take the promises of God's Word concerning prayer seriously. Let us all enter our Lord's school of prayer taught in this preaching series and be blessed as we seek God's blessings for His people, for the nation and the world. Faith thrives in an atmosphere of prayer. True prayer cultivates a deep spiritual hunger that draws us deeper into God. May the Spirit of God anoint us on this prayer journey that can truly change our lives. It is an exciting journey. It is a fulfilling journey. The glory be His!
